

## Curriculum Vitae of Dr. T. Rajgopal

Dr. T. Rajgopal (51 years) is the Vice President, Medical & Occupational Health with Hindustan Lever Limited (India) and is also the Head of Occupational Health for Unilever in Asia (including Australasia). As a member of the Unilever Corporate Occupational Health Committee, he helps to provide Unilever with a global occupational health strategy covering 90 countries.

Dr. Rajgopal holds postgraduate qualifications in Occupational Health, Public Health, Preventive Medicine as well as Health and Hospital Administration.

He was a Board member of the *International Commission on Occupational Health*. [ICOH] and is currently a Board member of the *MEDICHEM*. He is also on the Governing Board of the National Safety Council, India and the Board of Studies in Occupational Health of the Sri Ramachandra Medical College at Chennai.

Dr. Rajgopal has held advisory positions with the ILO/IPEC programme related to child labour under the National Safety Council, India., the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh as a technical expert following the Bhopal Gas Disaster and the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board of the Govt. of India on Occupational health. He has edited the Indian Journal of Occupational and Environmental Medicine [1994 – 2002] and has been the President of the Indian Association of Occupational Health, which is India's leading NGO in the discipline of occupational and environmental health [2003 – 2004].

Dr. Rajgopal has received the *Larsen and Toubro*, *C.K. Ramachandran*, *Bharat Electronics* and *Britannia awards* from the Indian Association of Occupational Health. The Indian Medical Association has awarded the *Ranbaxy* as well as the *Sir Nilratan Sircar Memorial* and *Anil Bhansal* orations to him.

In 2002 the Royal College of Physicians, London bestowed its Fellowship in Occupational Medicine on Dr. Rajgopal. Dr. Rajgopal underwent training in advanced leadership strategies for health care executives at the Harvard School of Public Health (2002) as well as another one on the analysis, scientific assessment and management of risks at the Harvard School of Public Health (2005). In addition he has been trained in general management, financial management and negotiation skills through Unilever's management training programmes.
