Description
<p>The 2001 KILM included 20 indicators designed to satisfy the ever-increasing demands of governments and the social partners for timely, accurate and accessible information on the world's labour markets. The foundation for the selection of the indicators was based on the following criteria: a) conceptual relevance, b) data availability, and c) relative comparability across economies and regions. Global coverage varied by indicator, as did time coverage, sometimes resulting in "spotty" and/or dated information for only a few years, particularly for some developing economies. It was obvious, therefore, that there was room for improvement in keeping with objective (b) above, i.e. widening the availability of the indicators.</p>
<p>This edition contains 31 tables corresponding to nine major substantive chapters on the following: economically active population; employment; unemployment; hours of work; wages; labour cost; consumer prices; occupational injuries; and strikes and lockout</p>
