2. Routine administrative information systems
3. Participatory and qualitative surveys

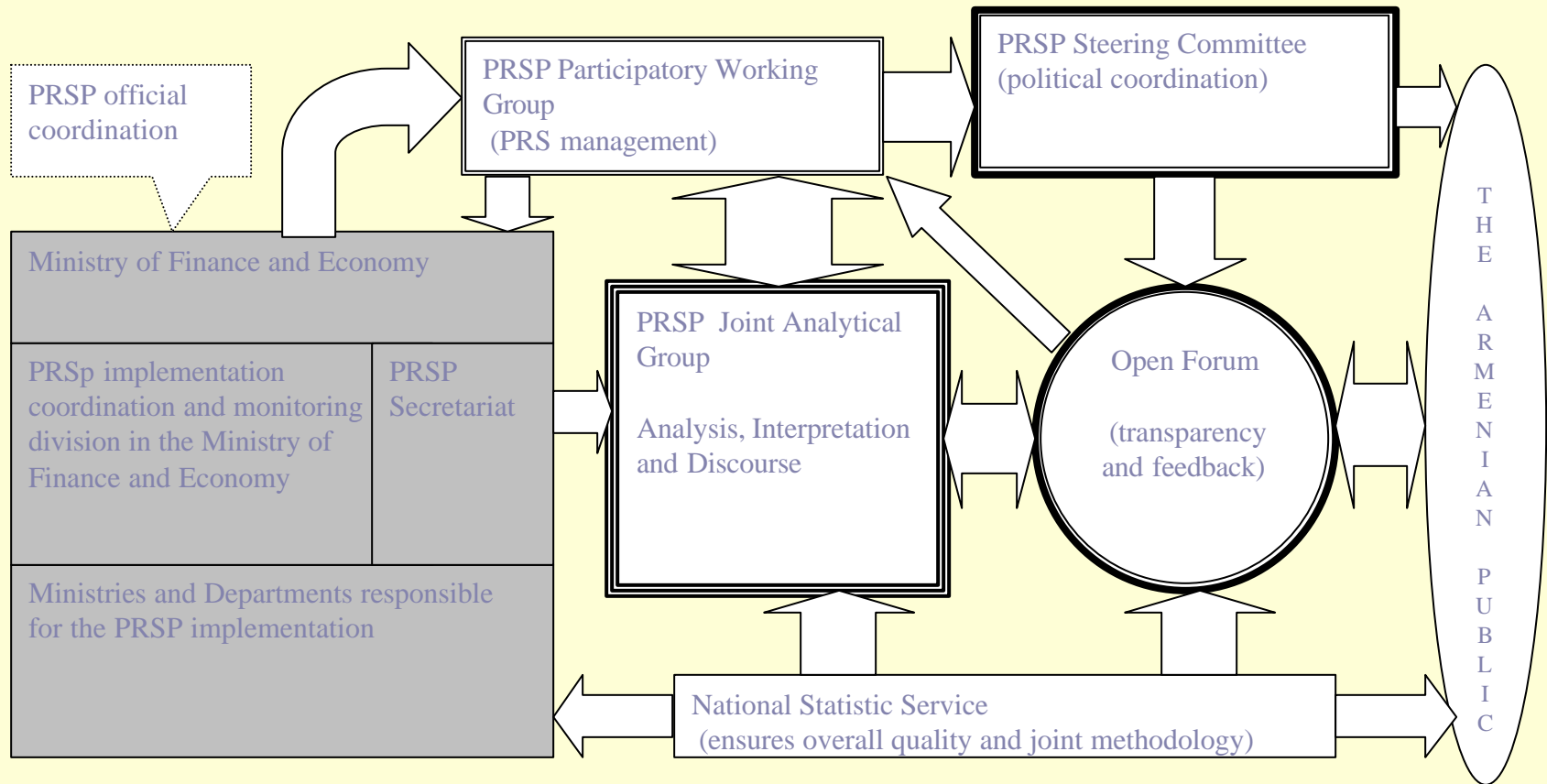
.....with different problems to go with it:

1. Time lags and slow feed back for policy
2. Facility-based, little info on service outreach
3. Work-intensive, no institutional basis

Who will be the beneficiary of data influences the system:

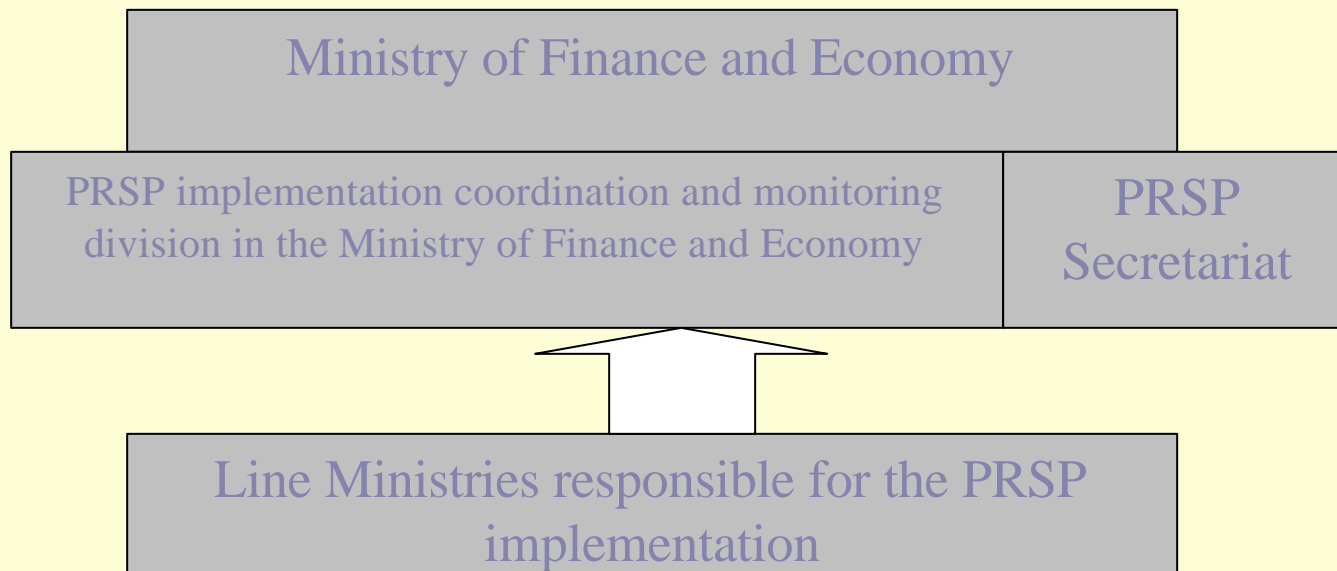
1. Government

The PRSP management monitoring system



PRSP implementation management

- More than 300 activities/projects are subject to implementation monitoring
 - 12 ministries/GOA agencies are responsible for this monitoring
- Special task forces are assigned within line ministries for the monitoring of the PRSP action plan, responsible for
- a) collecting information related to PRS implementation
 - b) collecting indicators for the PRS monitoring system
 - c) conducting primary analysis of the information provided
- Line ministries submit quarterly and annual reports on PRSP actions implementation



Participatory Governance System and the management monitoring system

PRSP Steering Committee

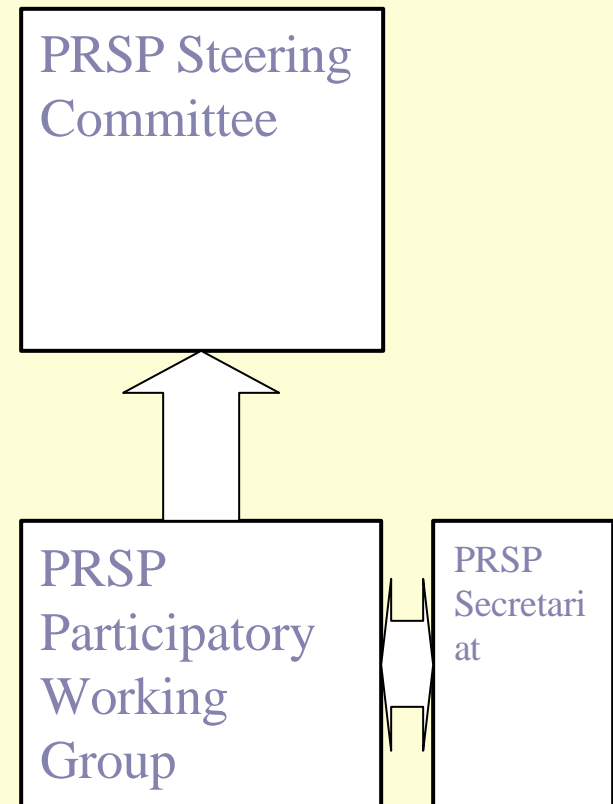
- Consists of RA Government, National Assembly, Church, Diaspora, NGO and Scientific Institutions' representatives, with responsibilities:
 - coordination of the PRSP implementation and monitoring system and political representation
 - preparation of PRSP update and submission to GOA

PRSP Participatory Working Group

- Day to day coordination of the PRSP implementation and monitoring system

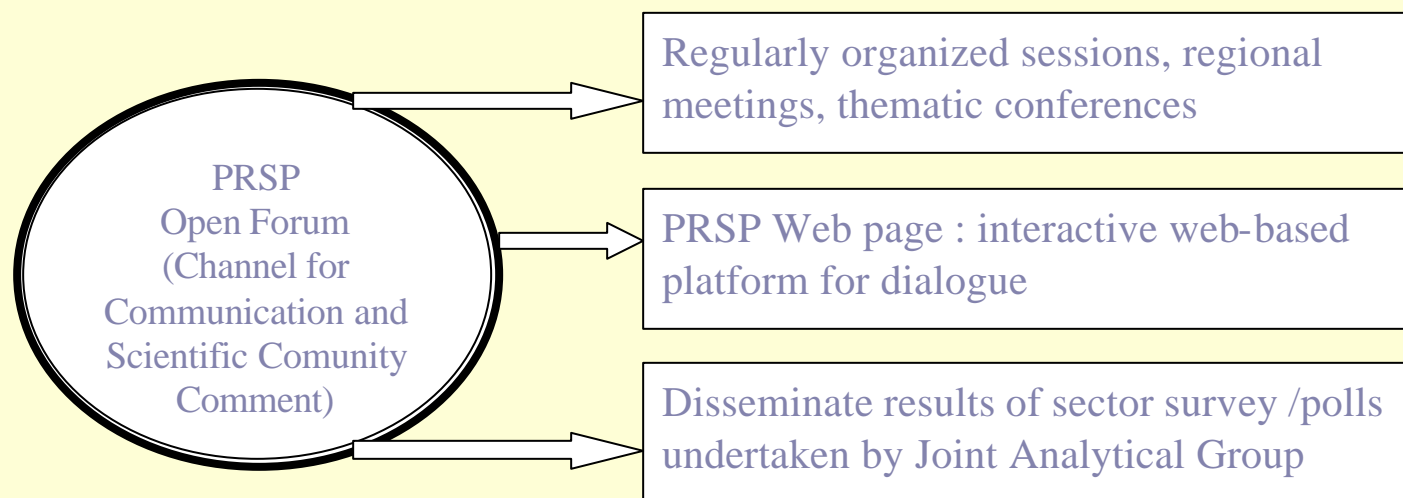
PRSP Secretariat

- supports management & moderation of WG and SC, Joint Analytical Group and the Open Forum,




Transparency of PRSP implementation and feedback: The Open Forum Concept

- Ensuring transparency of the PRSP implementation process, interpretation dialogue and feedback.
- Functioning through regularly organized sessions, regional meetings, interactive web page
- Assessing the PRSP implementation through sector surveys by the Joint Analytical Group and opinion polls conducted in the framework of the Open Forum



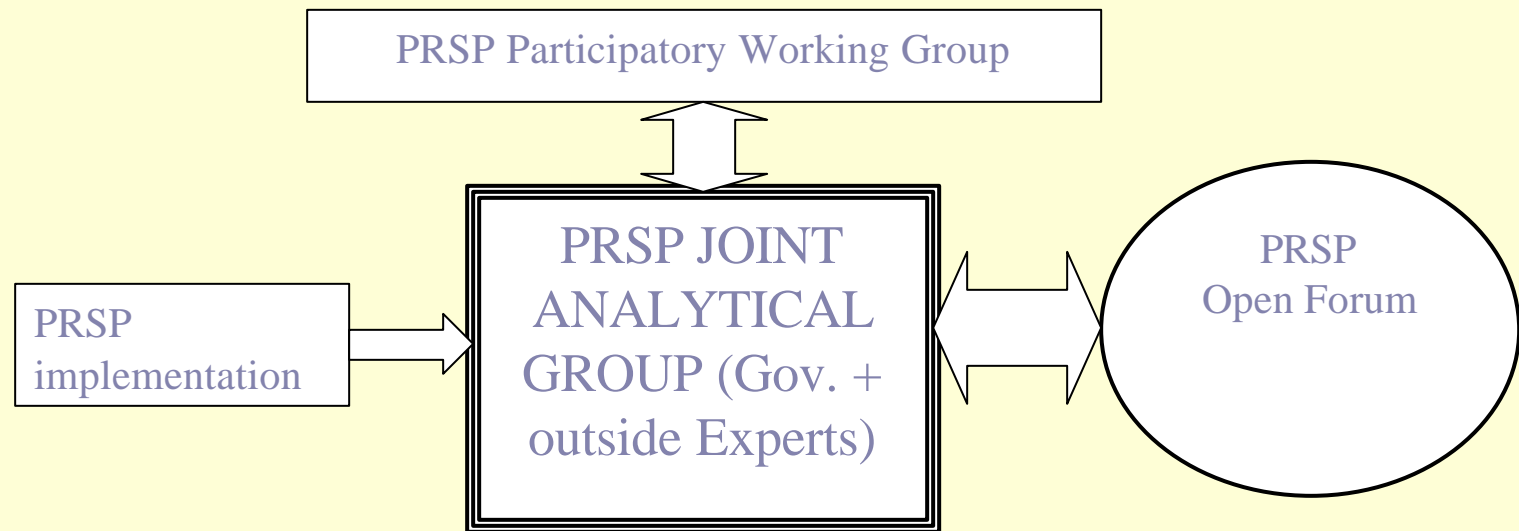


National Statistics Service (NSS)

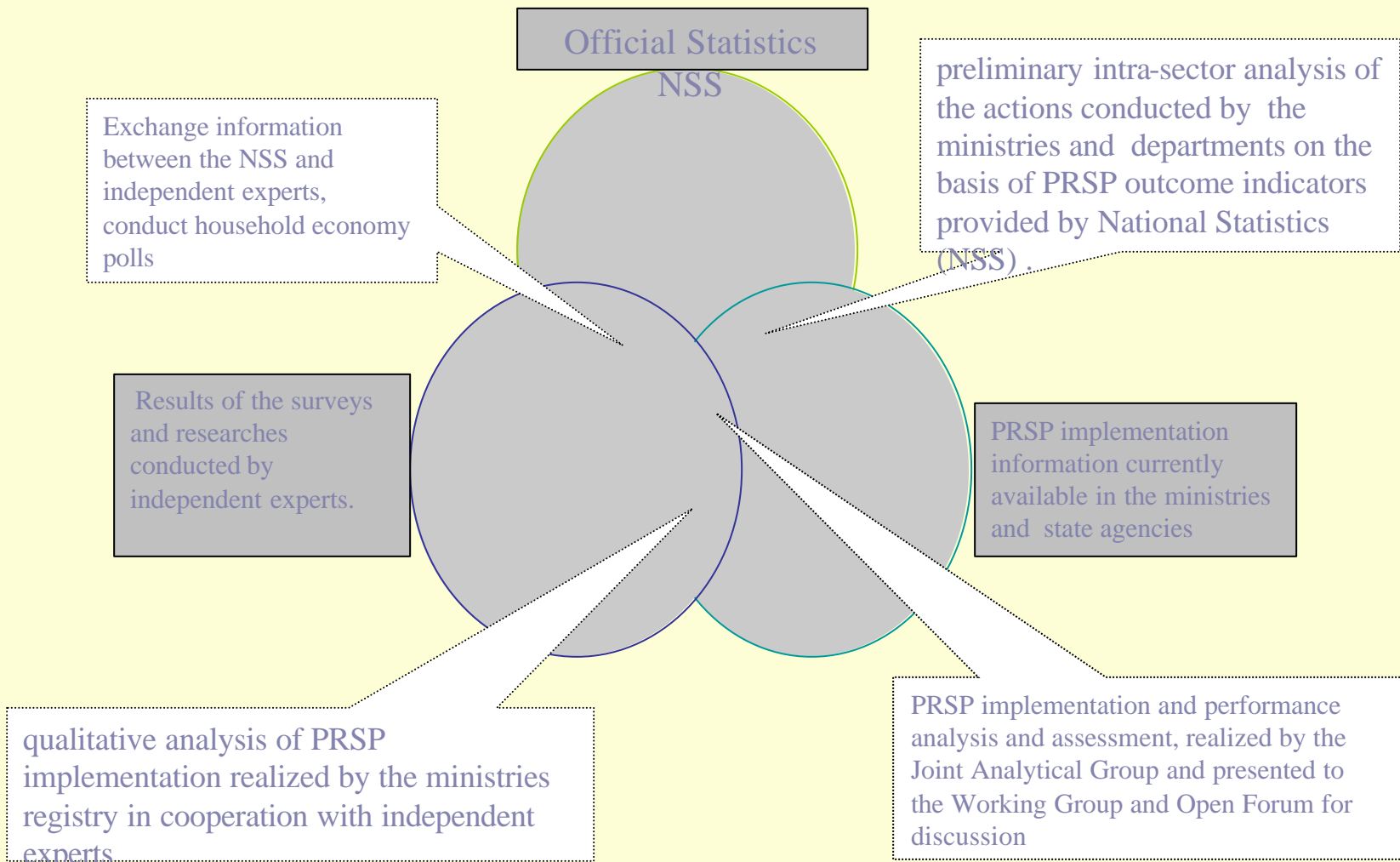
- resume of the PRSP monitoring indicators collected by the official statistics and conducting preliminary analysis
 - expertise of the indicators available in the PRSP monitoring system methodology
 - approval of the methodology, provision with necessary data and indicators to the responsible institutions (ministries and agencies)
 - provide necessary support to the Joint Analytical Group

PRSP JOINT ANALYTICAL GROUP

- analysis of PRSP implementation, cross-sector interrelations and outcomes;
- inter sector and multi factor assessment of PRSP implementation from the poverty impact aspect
- assessment of the accomplished PRSP action impact in the context of PRSP priorities
- elaborate proposals on PRSP reviews
